POSITION OVERVIEW

The ISO-ISM-DPA Instructor will teach ISO 9001, ISM Maritime Auditing, and Designated Person Ashore consultancy skills training to individuals pursuing knowledge, education, and training to obtain auditing experience.

This temporary position is expected to teach this week long course up to three times a year on a rotation with other pool members for the 2017 – 2018 academic year.

TEACHING

Teaching responsibilities include assessing student's ability to demonstrate their proficiency in quality, environmental, and safety management systems. Must have the ability to prepare potential auditors with the practical skills and techniques of the International Maritime Safety Management Systems, within the ISM Code and ISO 9001 Quality Management System.

DUTIES

- Teach continuing education students in areas assigned by the Department Head and reviewed from time to time by the Department Head.
- Assist CED with updates and language of course when needed.
- Assist in the development of learning materials, by preparing syllabus and lesson plans and maintaining records to monitor student progress, achievement and attendance.
- Participate in the development, administration and marking of exams and other assessments.
- Provide advice and support to students.
