- 10. Comply with Academy policies and Maine state laws governing conflicts of interest;
- 11. Handle fairly and efficiently issues of concern or dispute when they arise; and
- 12. Embrace values of diversity and principles of non-discrimination and equal opportunity in all educational and employment activities.
