Part-time CED Fast Rescue Boat Instructor (Pool)

POSITION OVERVIEW

The Fast Rescue Boat Instructor will teach the fundamentals of fast rescue to fire departments, companies, and individuals who work with fast rescue craft.

The Fast Rescue Boat Course is offered up to twelve times a year occur on 4-consecutive days or over the course of two weekends. This temporary part-time position is expected to teach the course on a rotation with other pool members for the 2017 – 2018 academic year.

DUTIES

- Teach continuing education students in the area of Fast Rescue Boat.
- Assessing student's ability to demonstrate their proficiency in the use of fast rescue boats.
- Assist CED with updates and language of course, when needed.
- Assist in the development of learning materials, by preparing syllabus and lesson plans and maintaining records to monitor student progress, achievement and attendance.
- Participate in the development, administration and marking of exams and other assessments.
- Provide advice and support to students.
- Position will require travel.

- Teaching and other forms of public presentation.
- Ability to write clearly and tailor communication style to meet the needs of the recipient.
- Ability to work collaboratively.
