Assistant Football Coach

The Assistant Football Coach is a full-time, 11-month (July 1 - May 31) benefitted position under the direction of the Head Football Coach. This position is responsible for coaching, recruiting and on-campus visit planning, game and practice planning, minor administrative tasks, and monitoring student-athlete academic performance. The Assistant Football Coach operates in accordance with Maine Maritime Academy, North Atlantic/New England Men's and Women's Athletic Conference, and NCAA rules, regulations and policies. The employee must be committed to promoting academic and athletic achievement in a way that is fully aligned with the mission of Maine Maritime Academy Athletics and the NCAA Division III philosophy

Coaching Duties

- Assist with teaching and coaching during practices and games.
- Assist with all practice planning and game planning.
- Assist with pre and post-season conditioning and weight training.
- Assist with academic monitoring and the personal development of student-athletes.
- Assist with evaluation and recruitment of academically qualified and highly skilled student-athletes.
- Contribute to building a positive team culture.
- Other duties as assigned.

This job description reflects the general duties of the job but is not a detailed description of all duties which may be inherent to the position. The Academy may assign reasonably related additional duties to individual employees consistent with policy and collective bargaining agreements.
