## **Project Manager, Construction & Site Development**

#### **POSITION OVERVIEW**

Employee reports to the Dean of Maritime Training and is responsible for the construction of a firefighting training facility for the Center for Professional Mariner Development (CPMD) that meets both civil and shipboard training requirements. This position will work with architects to develop initial drawings while coordinating with the Director of Facilities and Associate Vice President for Information Technology to establish infrastructure needs and interface with existing MMA capabilities. This position will also develop construction and equipment RFP's in conjunction with the established purchasing program and will recommend contract awards to the Dean of Maritime Training. Finally, the Project Manager will oversee the construction and installation of all aspects of the firefighting training facility. This is a Confidential, temporary full-time, benefits-eligible appointment. Initial appointment is for one year. Salary is \$80,000/year.

#### DUTIES

- Coordinates specifications for building site with Academy stakeholders.
- Works with architects and construction firms on developing requirements and writing Requests for Proposals (RFP).
- Provides recommendations on contract awarding.
- Overseas construction efforts, ensuring all aspects of the RFP are met and budgets are accurate.
- Other duties as assigned.

This job description reflects the general duties of the job but is not a detailed description of all duties, which may be inherent to the position. The Academy may assign reasonably related additional duties to individual employees consistent with policy and position.
