Temporary Able Bodied Seaman (AB), Summer Training Cruise

POSITION OVERVIEW

This position will assist with deck maintenance aboard the Training Ship State of Maine during the . Temporary position beginning on or about April 15, 2020 and ending on or about July 15, 2020, the dates for the summer training cruise as scheduled by Maine Maritime Academy.

The AB assists the ship's Bosun with regard to all daily deck maintenance activities including mooring and anchoring the vessel. Additionally, the AB may be required to act as vessel's helmsman or helmsman supervisor. This position reports to the Chief Mate of the training ship.

DUTIES

- Acts as a safety observer during any evolution. Working knowledge of/experience with Safety Management Systems is recommended.
- Acts as a trainer and mentor to cadets during deck maintenance activities.
- Active in all daily deck maintenance activities under the supervision of the Bosun or Licensed Deck Officers.

SKILLS

- Knowledge and familiarity with all shipboard systems and equipment.
- Experience as AB, or related experience.
- Ability to work with people in a closed, intense environment
- Ability to be flexible to changes of schedule.

- USCG Able Bodied Seaman Endorsement-Unlimited
- Medical Certificate (2 years)
- Certified lifeboatman
- STCW 2010 Endorsement
- Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC)

- Transportation Worker Identification Card (TWIC)
- Valid passport
- Candidate must pass a pre-employment drug test

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

While performing the duties of this job, this employee may:

- Be exposed to extremes in weather onboard ship, including rain, sleet, snow, rough seas;
- Regularly sit, walk through narrow passages, climb ladders;
- Use hands to manipulate objects, tools or controls;
- Reach with arms and hands;
- Lift and move up to 40 pounds;
- Work in areas of high noise levels.
