Temporary Assistant Sailing Coach - Fall 2020

This is a temporary position as an Assistant to the Sailing Programs/Sailing Coach. The incumbent is responsible for assisting in the coordinating, planning and coaching for the MMA intercollegiate sailing program. Employee will supervise practices, sometimes solo, and sometimes under guidance of the Head Coach; transport the team to and from regattas; coach and supervise team at regattas; and instruct sailing courses as needed. All of the duties of the position must be conducted in adherence with the policies, rules, and regulations of affiliated national, regional, and state intercollegiate athletic associations, any conference requirements (ICSA), and Academy policies and rules. The incumbent also works collaboratively with Waterfront Staff to ensure a quality experience while participating in Maine Maritime Sailing program or using its vessels. The incumbent must be committed to promoting the academic and athletic achievement in a way that is fully integrated with the mission and vision of Maine Maritime Academy.

This position requires experience sailing and racing dinghies and keelboats, and handling powerboats. The incumbent must have strong potential to teach, lead and counsel college student athletes. Valid U.S. driver's license is required. US Sailing Level 1 or equivalent is required; Level 2 or 3 is preferred. AED / CPR / First Aid Certification required within 30 days of hire. Position runs through November 1, 2020. Compensation is up to \$7500.
