

ASSISTANT FOOTBALL COACH

POSITION OVERVIEW

Assistant coaching positions are temporary, academic-year positions under the supervision of head coaches of the Academy's athletic teams. The incumbent must be able to immediately contribute to all phases of the football program, including but not limited to recruiting, film editing and review, game planning, conducting drills and one-on-one workouts, and assisting with operations. Appointments are for one academic year and include an hourly wage of \$21.00/hour plus housing for the duration of the appointment.
