

Temporary Counselor (1)

Maine Maritime Academy is seeking a temporary Counseling Contractor to provide short-term, in-person mental health support to students during a staffing transition within the Counseling Office. The contractor will work collaboratively with Student Services and Counseling staff to support student well-being, respond to concerns, and assist with crisis awareness and intervention when necessary. This is a temporary position for one month that will conclude upon the return of the Director of Counseling to full time office hours.

Skills:

- Provide in-person counseling services for students for up to 16 hours per week.
- Respond to Student of Concern reports and meet with students as appropriate.
- Schedule and conduct counseling appointments as deemed necessary by the Dean of Students and/or Director of Counseling Services.
- Serve on the SEA Team (Student Emergency/Assessment Team) as needed.
- Communicate promptly with the Director of Counseling Services, Dean of Students, or designee regarding any student expressing thoughts of harm to self or others.
- Collaborate with Counseling Office staff to ensure continuity of care and appropriate documentation practices.

Requirements

- Master's Degree
- Participate in required weekly supervision with designated MMA Counseling staff.
