Maine Maritime is seeking a part-time Assistant Women's Wrestling Coach. This is a temporary, academic-year position under the supervision of the program's head coach. Appointments are for one academic year and include an hourly wage of \$15.10/hour. Some appointments may include housing, depending on availability. Appointments may be renewed for successive years.
