Overview

. The spacious cockpit offers additional lounge space, and hatch access to engines and generator.

A masterpiece of engineering, the Huckins Seafarer 64 offers comfortable cruising accommodations for 7 in 4 staterooms plus the Captains stateroom. This captain maintained yacht has an enclosed climate controlled aft deck which has cross conversational seating while also being open to the lower helm by a full wet bar and offers 360 degree visibility for breathtaking panoramic views while underway. Down a few stairs is the salon with comfortable seating a a large flat screen TV making a second social gathering area. Walking forward from the lower Salon is a full galley with full sized stainless appliances and upgraded countertops and backsplash. Across from the galley is the Captains Stateroom and forward is a second stateroom with bunk beds and a head.

Aft from the lower Salon is a full electrical equipment room, a third stateroom with side by side single berths and a head across the passageway and aft of that is the master with a double bed to starboard and a single bed to port and ensuite head.

The large fly-bridge is an ideal place to socialize with family and friends, designed to seat 12-15 comfortably around a full second helm station. The spacious cockpit offers an additional lounge area, and hatch access to the engines & generator. Boat has been extensively updated and redecorated, and re-powered with Caterpillar 3126s. Excellent live-aboard with amenities for entertaining.

- New bilge pump in engine room
- All new zincs
- Replace portside stanchions & repair lifelines
- Varnish
- Repair foredeck sea locker + finish work
- Caulk seams in cockpit hatches gutters
- Remove and clean thru-hull strainers
- Port lower gudgeon
- Repair fiberglass near bow thruster on portside
- Dripless prop shaft seals; installed spray shields over seals to catch and direct water down into bilge
- New GEN belt
- Replaced insulations in port berth aft stateroom
