

# **Non-Regimental Student Packing List**

Please note: The items on this list are not required and this is meant as a guide to help you prepare for living on-campus in a Residence Hall and does not cover all permitted or not permitted items. ### Items provided for each resident in Curtis Hall

### Please do not bring

- x Echo devices/smart speakers not supported on the Academy network.
- x Heating elements (e.g. hot plate, toaster oven, space heater)
- x Electric fry pans, hot pots, crockpots, instapots, pressure cookers, etc.
- x Personal wireless router not supported on the network
- x Wireless printers not supported on the Academy network
- x Halogen lamps
- x Neon signs
- x Two-prong extension cords
- x Air conditioners
- x Any item with open flame (candles, incense burners, etc.)
- x Pets, other than a small fish in up to 10 gallon tank
- x Large furniture that will not fit in the room
- x One-of-a-kind or irreplaceable items
- x Weapons or ammunition (unless you are going to sign it into the Armory)
- x Flammable liquids
- x Hover boards
- x Electrical Tools
- x Electric blankets
- x Drug or alcohol paraphernalia
- x Alcohol or alcohol containers (unless you are 21+ living in The Commons)
- x Illegal or non-prescribed drugs (including marijuana in any form)
