**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

The application process for joining Maine Maritime Academy's Strategic Sealift Midshipman Program (SSMP) is comprised of several steps. All candidates will be evaluated and ranked based on their prior academic record, physical fitness abilities and an interview. Acceptance into SSMP is offered on an as-available basis to the most qualified candidates. Applications should be submitted to the MMA SIP Coordinator. Upon submission of this application, the SIP Coordinator will assist applicants with completing the supplemental materials: (Coast Guard Medical Evaluation & Physical Examination Form (CG-719K), the Physical Fitness Assessment, current academic materials, DoDMERB registration, scheduling an interview, and registering for the NROTC Unit's New Student Orientation.) Applicants are encouraged to submit their completed application early, prior to 1 August 2022. Students however can apply to join the unit at any time until their Junior or 2nd Class year at MMA.  
NOTE: Selection to the SSMP does not guarantee receipt of the Student Incentive Payment (SIP). SIP applications are handled separately.
