## Acadia National Park

**Approximately 47 miles, 1 hour 10 minutes**  
**Headquarters – 567 Eagle Lake Rd. Bar Harbor, ME 04609**

Acadia National Park is a 47,000-acre Atlantic coast recreation area primarily on Maine's Mount Desert Island. Its landscape is marked by woodland, rocky beaches, and glacier-scoured granite peaks such as Cadillac Mountain the highest point on the United States' East Coast. The bayside town of Bar Harbor, with restaurants and shops, is a popular gateway.

## Surrounding Area Attractions

**Fort Knox and Penobscot Narrows Observatory**  
**Approximately 19 miles, 25 minutes**

Fort Knox was established in 1844 to protect the Penobscot River valley against a possible future British naval incursion. The newly constructed Penobscot Narrows Bridge boasts an observation tower, rising 420' above sea level, which can only be accessed through the Fort.

**Ellsworth**  
**Approximately 32 miles, 40 minutes**

Ellsworth is the county seat of Hancock County with several shopping centers and restaurants to choose from.

**Bangor**  
**Approximately 38 miles, 55 minutes**

Bangor is the largest market town, transportation hub, and media center in a five-county area. Bangor City Forest and other nearby parks offer hiking, canoeing, and fishing. Bangor provides many shopping and dining opportunities.

**Belfast**  
**Approximately 36 miles, 50 minutes**

A quaint waterfront town of 6,600, their Main Street has many wonderful dining and shopping opportunities, and a varied selection of the arts.
