



Regimental Student Packing List

March 2024

Upon arrival at MMA students will check in with multiple offices across campus. Prior to arriving regimental students should have completed several actions. One of these actions is submitting your uniform fitting sheet <https://admissions.mainemaritime.edu/register/UniformFitting2024> (by the first week of May). This allows the Bookstore to have all your necessary RPT items ready for pick up at check in, as well as the subsequent issues throughout the fall semester.

When TSSOM leaves Castine in May it will not be returning to Castine due to pier construction in preparation for the new NSMV. This will require berthing in Curtis Hall for RPT. You will check in to your Curtis Hall room on 18 August. You should separate the items you bring to MMA as directed below – some items for RPT and some items for after RPT. Items provided for each resident in Curtis Hall

- Twin XL sized bed
- Mattress
- Desk and bookshelf
- Desk chair
- Free standing closet/wardrobe
- 2-3 drawer dresser

Bring from home for RPT

- Swimsuit/trunks
- Running/gym shoes (conservative in color/appearance, suggest 2 pairs)
- Safety Boot (see video on New Student Information page for guidance)
- Underwear (suggest 10 pairs)
- Pillow
- Razors - males are required to shave daily (electric razors are allowed AFTER RPT)
- Iron and ironing board (coordinate/share with roommate, only one needed per room)
- Any items required for participation in athletics (personal protective gear, equipment)
- Wastebasket
- Personal care products
- Shower shoes
- Towels and washcloths
- Free-standing fan



Bring from home for after RPT

These items are allowed after the completion of RPT (Regimental Preparatory Training). You can bring them with you upon arrival and they will be placed in storage. You will have access to them before convocation/ the start of classes.

- Laptop and chargers
- Phone and chargers
- Alarm clock
- Floor or desk lamp
- Printer
- “Egg crate” or memory foam mattress pad
- Poster (one only and must be in good taste)
- Framed picture (one only and must be in good taste)
- Academic supplies (notebooks, folders, binders, pencils, pens, index cards, etc.)

Items not Allowed

These items are not allowed during your Fourth Class year.

- TV, DVD player
- Microwave/toaster
- Refrigerator
- Xbox, PlayStation, Nintendo, etc.
- Coffee maker
- Closed-coil hot water heater
- Additional furniture beyond what is provided in your room in Curtis Hall
- Electric blankets, heating lamps, or heating pads
- Sound system

Items provided in your SEA BAG

These items will be provided by the bookstore and will be issued throughout RPT and your 4/c year. Posted separately and included in the Cost of Attendance.

Items provided by Residential Life for convenience

The following items are kept in Curtis Hall; students can contact their Residential Assistant (RA) when these items are needed.

- Vacuum
- Mop and bucket
- Broom and dustpan
- Basic cleaning supplies (*cleaner, paper towels, sponge, etc.*)
- Toilet paper
