Castine


- Explore Castine's charming downtown and historic district.

Acadia National Park

Approximately 47 miles, 1 hour 10 minutes Headquarters – 567 Eagle Lake Rd. Bar Harbor, ME 04609

Acadia National Park is a 47,000-acre Atlantic coast recreation area primarily on Maine's Mount Desert Island. Its landscape is marked by woodland, rocky beaches, and glacier-scoured granite peaks such as Cadillac Mountain the highest point on the United States' East Coast. The bayside town of Bar Harbor, with restaurants and shops, is a popular gateway.



Surrounding Area Attractions

Fort Knox and Penobscot Narrows Observatory Approximately 19 miles, 25 minutes

Fort Knox was established in 1844 to protect the Penobscot River valley against a possible future British naval incursion. The newly constructed Penobscot Narrows Bridge boasts an observation tower, rising 420' above sea level, which can only be accessed through the Fort.

Ellsworth

Approximately 32 miles, 40 minutes

Ellsworth is the county seat of Hancock County with several shopping centers and restaurants to choose from.

Bangor

Approximately 38 miles, 55 minutes

Bangor is the largest market town, transportation hub, and media center in a five-county area. Bangor City Forest and other nearby parks offer hiking, canoeing, and fishing. Bangor provides many shopping and dining opportunities.

Belfast


Approximately 36 miles, 50 minutes
