## DEDICATION

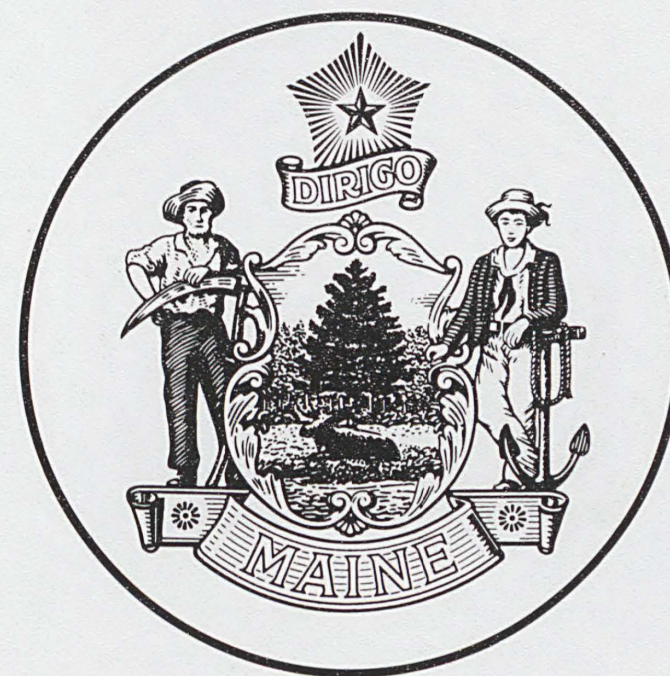

## MMA Flareup Being Aired

CASTINE — A student committee will meet with the administration of Maine Maritime Academy here in a day or two to discuss last week's flare-up of student demands.

Student sentiment peaked during regular morning formation on Friday, Rear Admiral Edward Rodgers and students concurred, when questioned by the NEWS Thursday.

The student body of 470 young men standing at attention outside received Capt. William Brennan's usual command to fall out that day at about 7:45 a.m. But the bulk of the formation remained — an estimated 375.

The same command was given three times, while the men refused to move. Rodgers gave the final order after he requested a random group of students to discuss student demands in his office.

Two students — one who followed the first order and one who did not — said the forma-

tion stood until 9 a.m. but Rodgers said the incident lasted one-half-hour.

The student representatives told Rodgers the student body was upset because the traditional lifting of the Friday afternoon "regimental formation" had not been accomplished but was to remain in effect in addition to other restrictions resulting from a food-throwing incident the week before.

The weekend in question was a special one, that being annual "Homecoming."

During that time span local officials were called in to examine a janitor's closet destroyed by fire on the fourth floor of the new dormitory. "I don't know if this has any bearing on the students' recent actions," Rodgers explained.

On Oct. 2, John Markley, engineering instructor, tendered his resignation to be effective in December, following a letter from Rodgers which placed him on probation, because he disappeared.

proved of the instructors bringing various complaints to the press.

The letter instructs Markley to discuss only school material with students, and recommends he not contact the press.

Lt. Cmdr. Markley, USMS chief engineer, has been with MMA for five years, and is popular with students.

As a result of the students' reaction, Rodgers handed down 50 demerits to all seniors and 15-20 demerits to underclassmen who were involved in the Friday formation incident. The school allows 130 demerits a school year before expulsion.

"This is no real jeopardy to

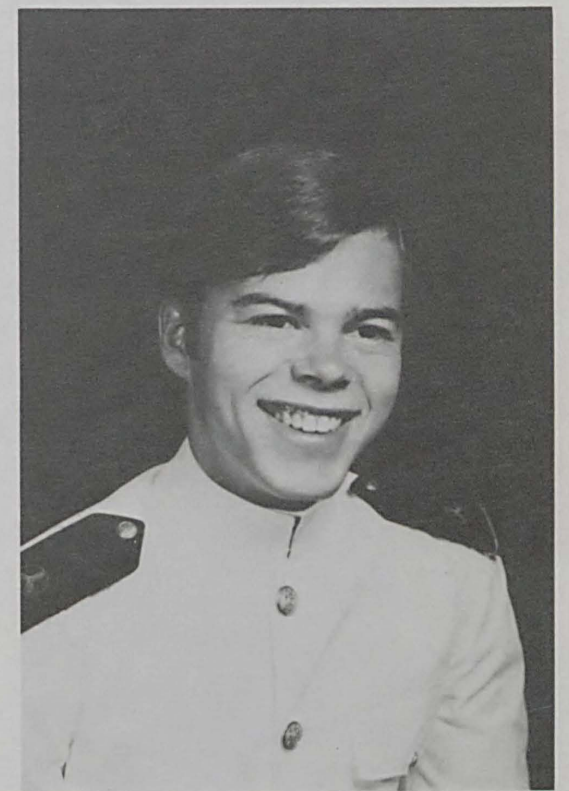
the students, they have an opportunity to redeem themselves," Rodgers told the NEWS. But this is not the students' understanding: "Once you get demerits, they're permanent," a senior regimental officer said Wednesday.

The students, according to a junior and senior, who wished to remain anonymous spokesmen, cited the prohibition of mustaches, sideburns, unpolished shoes, the occasional beer, missing classes due to "watch" duty and maintenance of the training vessel as causes of the demonstrations.

"This is not real life . . . my father graduated from this school and he's been on many men of 22 and 23 and 24."
