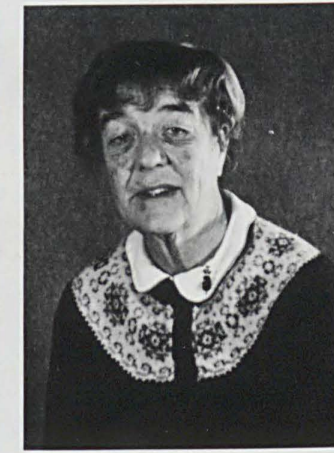
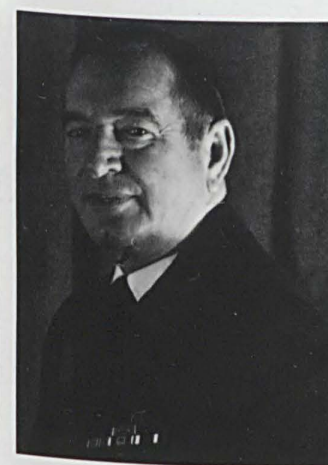
As you leave the Academy to join the ranks of Maine Maritime alumni, I wish you every success in the profession you have chosen and for which you have strived so hard.
