To the Class of 1983

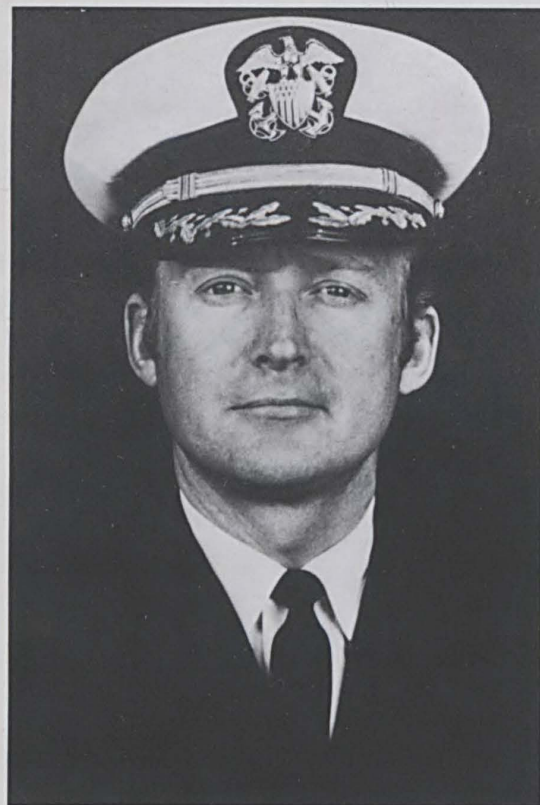

The 1982 Mariners, coming off a successful season in 1981, continued their ways posting a 7-2-1 record. After graduating eight starters from last year's team, and only five seniors coming back, we had a very young team. The offense was to be our strong point with the return of an experienced offensive line led by seniors Joe Clark, Dana Merrill, and Pete Geissler. The defense, led by its only senior, Jim Brown, and junior Steve Durrell, had to rely on many underclassmen due to the loss of six starters from last year's squad. They gained much experience and improved as the season progressed.

The highlight of the season was when offensive guard Joe Clark was named to the first team of the NAIA All American Team, the first player ever from MMA. His number was then retired, in which the number 75 will never be worn again. This was only the second time in the school's history that a player's number has been retired.

Although we had seven big wins, there were a couple of disappointing losses. There was the loss to Plymouth State in a game for first place, and the loss to our arch rivals Mass. Maritime, ending our three year domination of the Admiral's Cup.

After four years, this year's senior class compiled a record of 26-10-1, with only one loss on Ritchie Field, showing the development of a strong football program at Maine Maritime. The Mariners are now a force to be reckoned with in the New England Football Conference.

Graduating this year will be Tri-Captains Joe Clark, Dana Merrill, and Jim Brown along with seniors Pete Geissler, and Dan Rideout. Also graduating will be Coach Tip MacDonald, and managers Tim Mitchell and Rick Drane.

The Maine Maritime men's varsity basketball team returned to action after a 10 year lay-off. The first season was very successful with the Mariners finishing in second place in the Northeast College Conference with a 4-4 record and a 8-12 record overall.

Team captains Jeff Cutting and Conrad L'Heureux led the way for the first year team. Cutting holds the schools individual rebounding record for one game with 18 and L'Heureux also set a new mark for steals. Both ranked very high in each respective category in conference play. These two outstanding players will be a tough loss for the team and will put a heavy load on the backs of the returning underclassmen. Cutting's soft touch and physical size were two aspects of his game that made opposing coaches take extreme notice. L'Heureux's tenacious defense and unselfish team play complimented the scorers on the team.

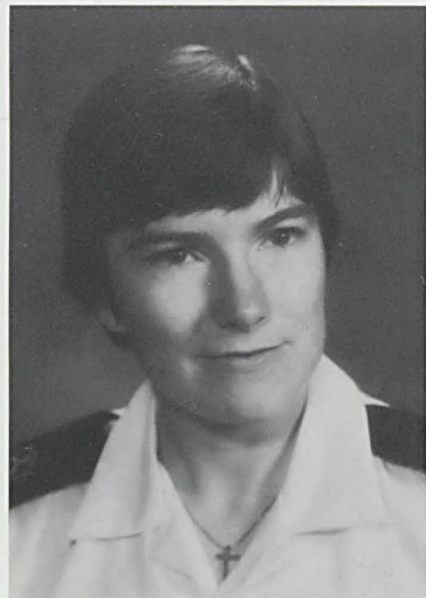
My Family — Thanks
