The Maine Maritime men's varsity basketball team returned to action after a 10 year lay-off. The first season was very successful with the Mariners finishing in second place in the Northeast College Conference with a 4-4 record and a 8-12 record overall.

Team captains Jeff Cutting and Conrad L'Heureux led the way for the first year team. Cutting holds the schools individual rebounding record for one game with 18 and L'Heureux also set a new mark for steals. Both ranked very high in each respective category in conference play. These two outstanding players will be a tough loss for the team and will put a heavy load on the backs of the returning underclassmen. Cutting's soft touch and physical size were two aspects of his game that made opposing coaches take extreme notice. L'Heureux's tenacious defense and unselfish team play complimented the scorers on the team.

First year coach Ed Biggie has a firm foundation of underclassmen returning with team leading scorer Adam St. John, leading rebounder Jimmy Patterson and assist man Mike McKenzie, all starters this year. St. John's 33 points vs. U.M. Farmington is a new school record. Patterson was second in the state in shooting percentage which is another school record. Mike McKenzie, another sophomore, holds the school's assist record with 15 in one game. Other returning underclassmen which round out next year's team include sharpshooter John Paulsen, rebounder Pat Wrey and the very physical Andy Martin.

A very sincere note of thanks to Asst. Coach Bill Allen for the hard work and dedication he devoted to this year's team. It was greatly appreciated! The team would also like to express their gratitude to our coach, Ed Biggie, for a job well done as a first year head coach. Thank You!!
