#### Toward the Mark

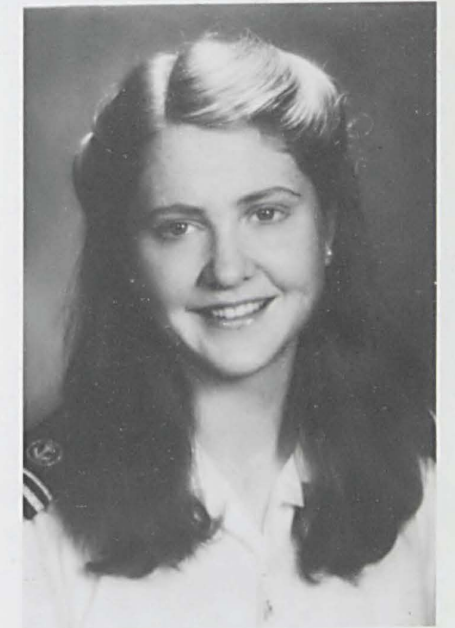
