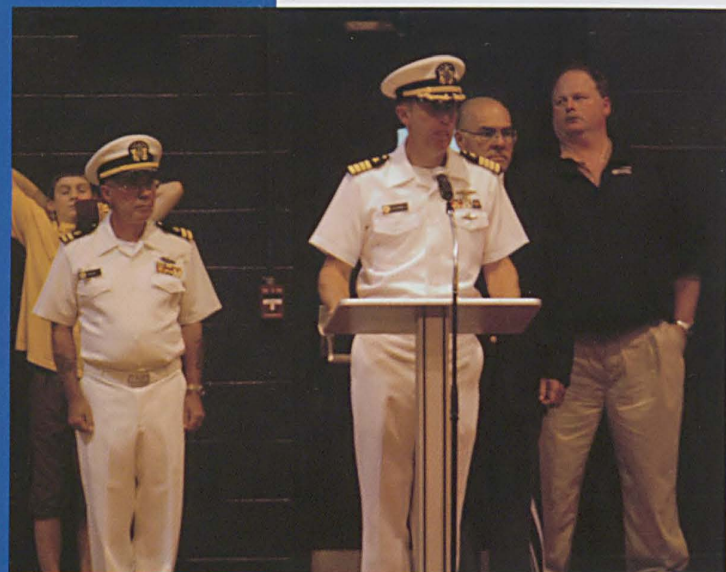


# Homecoming
