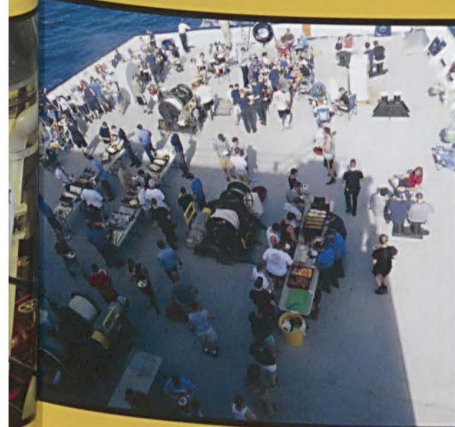
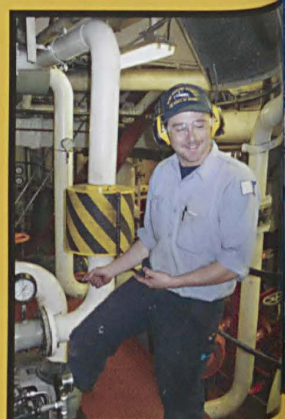


CRUISE 2014
